The 37th FIMAV 2021 is offering a range of events that promise extraordinary experiences in full compliance with the restrictions imposed by the current situation. All the measures prescribed by Public Health will be rigorously implemented to ensure the health and safety of the artists, the public and our teams in the field. Thus, the schedule has been designed to respect a 9:30 p.m. curfew, our three halls—Carré 150 (Salle Les-

Frères-Lemaire), Colisée Desjardins and Église St-Christophe d'Arthabaska—will be configured to maintain physical distancing at all times, seats will be assigned, and the procedural mask will be mandatory (no exceptions!), to name only a few measures. The FIMAV team remains constantly on alert and is preparing for any eventuality by closely monitoring the evolution of the pandemic in Quebec. Thanks to the rigour and professionalism of our team members, the 37th FIMAV 2021 will be a safe gathering that will leave a lasting impression in the hearts and minds of those looking for living artistic experiences!
