And now, for the first time ever, we have an unexpected change to the concert line-up one month before the event. Thus, we regretfully announce that Fátima Miranda must cancel her visit to Victoriaville for personal reasons.

To replace such a great singer, the artistic direction of the 38th FIMAV has turned to Japanese vocalist Koichi Makigami. Makigami is renowned as a master of the oldest instrument in the world and recognized worldwide for his unique voice, his confounding extended techniques and his contagious sense of humour. To hear him vocalize—especially in free improvisation mode—is to embark on a singular journey beyond the glottis!
