REGARD SUR LE FIMAV — AN EXHIBITION BY MARTIN MORISSETTE

Tuesday, May 10, 2022—At the invitation of the City of Victoriaville’s Recreation, Culture and Community Life Department, photographer Martin Morissette will be presenting an exhibition entitled “REGARD SUR LE FIMAV” from May 16 to August 16, 2022, on large double-sided panels installed on rue de la Gare.

Martin Morissette has been the official photographer of the Festival International de Musique Actuelle de Victoriaville since 2000. This exhibition will present an overview of his work at FIMAV in the last decade (2011-2021). The 42 photos selected for the exhibition are part of a large bank of snapshots that document more than 400 concerts presented as part of FIMAV.



The public will be able to admire Martin Morissette’s photographs starting May 16, 2022, the same day the 38th FIMAV will be inaugurating its circuit of sound art installations in public places. On rue de la Gare, where Morissette’s exhibition is presented, there will also be two sound art installations by Pascale Leblanc Lavigne entitled “Les fours à micro-ondes sont-ils bannis en Russie?” and “Les belles tuiles à plafond.”
